

THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE C. PRAVEEN KUMAR

WRIT PETITION No.1207 OF 2017

ORDER:

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Government Pleader for Stamps and Registration appearing for the respondents. With their consent, the Writ Petition is disposed of at the admission stage itself.

2. The present Writ Petition came to be filed with the following prayer:

“..to issue writ order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus to declare the action of the respondent No.3 in issuing the impugned Memo No.A1/785/2016, dated 27.12.2016 returning the application of the petitioner submitted for renewal of notary by relying upon the impugned memo No.31617/Regn.II/A1/2012-4, dated 31.08.2015 issued by the 1st respondent directing the respondent No.3 to withhold the request of renewal of Notaries as arbitrary, illegal and violation of article 19(1)(g) of the Constitution of India and contrary to the provisions of Notaries Act and Rules and consequently, direct the respondents to renew the licence of Certificate of Practice of Notary for further period.”

3. It is represented by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the issue involved in the writ petition is squarely covered by an Order of this Court, dated 02.12.2016, rendered in W.P.No.9655 of 2016 and Batch. The same is not disputed by the learned Government Pleader for Stamps and Registration.

4. In that view of the matter, following the said order, this Writ Petition is allowed in terms of the Order dated 02.12.2016 passed in W.P.No.9655 of 2016 and Batch.

Consequently, Miscellaneous Petitions, if any, pending in this Writ Petition shall stand closed. There shall be no order as to costs.
