THIS COURT MADE THE FOLLOWING

ORDER: (per Hon'ble Sri Justice C.V.Nagarjuna Reddy)

This Writ Petition is filed for issue of *Habeas Corpus* by directing respondent No. 4 to produce Bosi Mercy (hereinafter referred to as 'the detainee'), D/o Bosi Appala Raju, before the Court.

2. On 27-12-2016, the alleged detainee was produced by the police from the custody of respondent No. 4 who was also personally present. On the counseling of the Court, respondent No. 4, who is already married, has undertaken to file an affidavit to the effect that he will not trouble the alleged detainee and insist her on marrying him and he has also agreed to engage a counsel to appear on his behalf.

3. Today at the hearing, the alleged detainee and respondent No. 4 are present. The mother of the alleged detainee is also present. As undertaken, respondent No. 4 has filed an undertaking affidavit, wherein he has *inter alia* stated as under:

"I submit that the above Writ Petition has been filed for issuance of Writ of Habeas Corpus and the above Writ Petition came up for hearing on 27-12-2016 on which the detainee was produced and she agreed to go along with her parents and this Hon'ble Court directed me to give an undertaking that I will not interfere with the personal life and liberty of the detainee.

I submit that I am working in Indian Army and I have old aged parents who are depended upon me and I hereby undertake that I will not interfere with the personal life and liberty of the detainee in any manner."

Respondent No. 4 has also orally assured the Court that he will not interfere with the life of the alleged detainee.

4. Having regard to the undertaking affidavit given by respondent No. 4 and the fact that the alleged detainee has already joined her parents, the Writ Petition is closed.
