

HONOURABLE SRI JUSTICE RAJA ELANGO

WRIT PETITION No.879 of 2017

ORDER:

1. This writ petition is filed by the petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking to quash the proceedings against him in Crime No.133 of 2011 on the file of the 3rd respondent.
2. Heard and perused the material available on record.
3. It is stated in the affidavit that the above crime was registered for the offences under Sections 420, 468 and 471 IPC. It is alleged that the petitioner and other bank employees played fraud in sanctioning loans on the fake documents. It is the case of the petitioner that he has not committed any offence as alleged.
4. The petitioner filed this writ petition challenging the investigation in the above crime. This Court is not inclined to interfere with the investigation in the above crime. However, the official respondents are directed to complete the investigation and file a final report, in accordance with law, without arresting the petitioner. The petitioner is directed to appear before the Station House Officer concerned as and when required and he is also directed to execute a personal bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with one surety for the like sum to the satisfaction of the Station House Officer concerned, as surety for his future appearance as and when required for the purpose of investigation.
5. With the above direction, the Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs. Consequently, miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
