I hereby made clear that on the next date of hearing, no adjournment shall be granted on any reason whatsoever.”

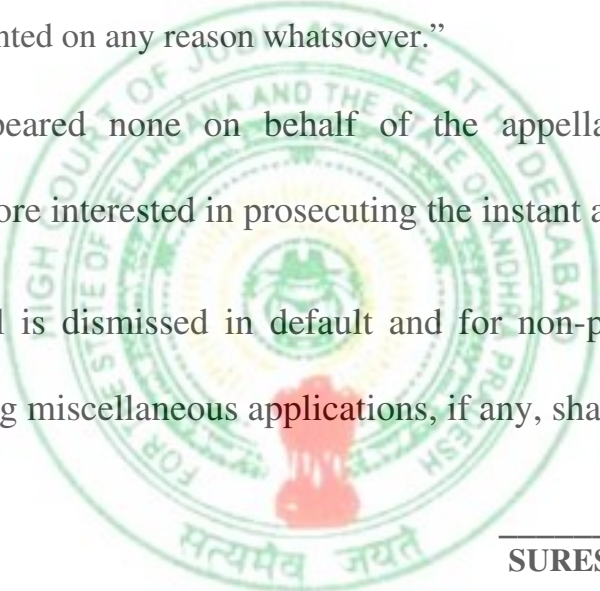
2. Today appeared none on behalf of the appellant. It seems the appellant is no more interested in prosecuting the instant appeal.
