CRIMINAL APPEAL No.227 of 2011

JUDGMENT: (per Dr. Justice Shameem Akther)

This criminal appeal, under Section 374(2) Cr.P.C., arises out of the judgment dated 28.01.2010 in Sessions Case No.92 of 2009 on the file of the learned Judge, Family Court-cum-Additional District and Sessions Judge, Vizianagaram, whereby the appellant/accused was convicted for the offence punishable under Section 304 Part-II I.P.C. and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for a period of ten years and to pay a fine of Rs.500/-, in default to suffer rigorous imprisonment for a period of one month.

Learned Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent/State, having received written instructions, submitted that after completion of eight years of imprisonment, the appellant/accused was granted remission and released on 04.04.2017.

In view of the above, this appeal does not survive for adjudication on merits and is accordingly dismissed.
