ORDER:

CRL.P.MP.No. 12239 OF 2017

This miscellaneous petition is filed under Section 320 of Cr.P.C seeking permission to compromise and compound the offences to quash the proceedings in C.C.No.761 of 2015 on the file of VI Additional Junior Civil Judge, Guntur, for the offence punishable under Section 498-A IPC & Sections 3 & 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act.

The petitioner/Accused No.2 and the second respondent/defacto complainant are present and they are identified by their respective counsel and produced Photostat copies of Aadhar cards to prove their identity.

A compromise deed dated 02.11.2017 is filed by both the parties, when terms of joint memo of compromise are explained in Telugu language, they are admitted to be true and correct. Further, it is now submitted that, both the petitioner/Accused No.2 and the second respondent/defacto complainant voluntarily entered into compromise due to intervention of elders and well-wishers and they wanted to lead peaceful life.

Therefore, I find that the compromise is voluntary in the interest of both parties and permission is granted to compound the offence. Hence, compromise is recorded in terms of the compromise memo dated 02.11.2017 filed along with this petition. Accordingly, this petition is ordered.

Consequently, miscellaneous applications pending if any, shall also stand closed. No costs.
