W.P.No. 19590 of 2013

ORDER:-

The petitioner complains against inaction of the respondents in registering crime on the complaint dated 30.06.2012 as illegal and arbitrary.

The learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home while referring to written instructions of even date submits that the complaint dated 30.06.2012 has been registered as Crime No. 272 of 2014 for the offences punishable under Sections 143, 341 and 307 read with 149 IPC. The investigation officer has sent proposal to Sub-Division Police Officer, Guntur for referring the crime as false. The S.D.P.O., Gudur, through orders in C.No.950/ GL-SDOG/ 2015, permitted to file a report.

It is a fact that the petitioner is not yet served with either referral notice or copy of the final report. The learned Assistant Government Pleader informs the Court that respondent Nos.3 and 4 would communicate copy of the referral notice or report to the petitioner within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

The statement is placed on record and accepted. The petitioner, if so advised, is given liberty to workout his remedies after he receives referral notice/ report.

The writ petition is accordingly disposed of. No order as to costs.

As a sequel, Miscellaneous Petitions, if any pending, shall stand disposed of as infructuous.
