

THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE T. SUNIL CHOWDARY

CRIMINAL PETITION No.5290 of 2017

ORDER:

1 This petition is filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C to quash the proceedings against the petitioners / Accused No.1 to 4 in C.C.No.188 of 2016 on the file of the Court of the Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Palasa, Srikakulam District.

2 At the time of arguments, the only relief, which the learned counsel for the petitioners, has sought is that the presence of the petitioners/accused Nos.2 to 4 before the trial Court may be dispensed with on each and every date of adjournment. He further submitted that the first petitioner / A.1 will attend the trial Court to ensure the progress of the trial of the case. In view of the submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court is not inclined to go into the merits of the main case.

3 There is no dispute with the regard to the identity of the petitioner Nos.2 to 4, who are accused Nos.2 to 4 and even if their presence is dispensed with, no prejudice will be caused to the second respondent.

4 Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, the presence of the petitioner Nos.2 to 4, who are accused Nos.2 to 4 in C.C.No.188 of 2016 on the file of the Court of the Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Palasa, Srikakulam District, is dispensed with on each and every date of adjournment.

However, they shall appear before the trial Court as and when their presence is so required.

5 With the above observations, this Criminal Petition is disposed of. As a sequel, the miscellaneous petitions, pending if any in this Criminal Petition, shall stand closed.
