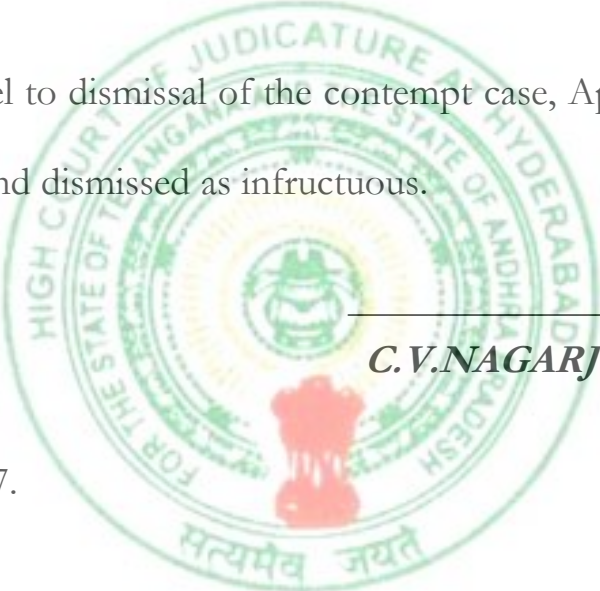
JUDGMENT: (*per Hon'ble Sri Justice C.V.Nagarjuna Reddy*)

This contempt case is filed alleging willful disobedience of order dated 10-10-2013 in W.P.No. 19171 of 2012.

2. At the hearing, learned counsel, representing Sri Jalli Kanakaiah, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners, has submitted that the cause in the contempt case does not survive for adjudication.

3. Accordingly, the contempt case is dismissed as infructuous.

4. As a sequel to dismissal of the contempt case, Application No. 162 of 2016 shall stand dismissed as infructuous.
