

HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE A.RAJASHEKER REDDY

WRIT PETITION No.15197 OF 2017

ORDER:

The case of the petitioner is that he has submitted an application dated 13.05.2016 in Form-VIA as per Rule 18 and Section 4(1) of the A.P.Rights in Land and Pattadar Pass Books Act, 1971 to the 3rd respondent for issuance of pattadar pass books and title deeds in respect of the land admeasuring Sy. No.725 an extent of Ac.1-57 cents, Sy. No.724 an extent of Ac.0.67, Sy. No.726 an extent of 0.43 cents, Sy. No.727 an extent of Ac.1.45 cents, Sy. No 735 an extent of Ac.1.48 cents, Sy. No. 722 an extent of 0.10 cents, Sy. No. 752 an extent of Ac.3.39 cents and out of it Ac. 1.70 cents, Sy. No.721-1 an extent of Ac. 0-80, Sy. No. 721-2 an extent of Ac.0.64 cents, Sy. No.736 Ac.1.16 cents, Sy. No.753 an extent of Ac.1.00 cents, Sy. No. 751 an extent of Ac.0.77 cents, Sy. No.741 an extent of Ac.2.63 cents, Sy. No.739-A an extent of Ac.4.96 cents, Sy. No.739-B an extent of Ac.2-71 cents and Sy. No.740 an extent of Ac.2.69 cents respectively, situated at Thummala village, Amadaguru Mandal, Anantapur District. As no action is being taken on the said application, the present writ petition is filed.

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue.

Since the application of the petitioner dated 13.05.2016 is stated to be pending before the 3rd respondent, without going into the merits of the case, the 3rd respondent is directed to

dispose of the same, in accordance with law, within a period of eight (08) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

With the above direction, the writ petition is disposed of.
No order as to costs.

As a sequel thereto, miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending in the writ petition, shall stand closed.
