

HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE A.RAJASHEKER REDDY

WRIT PETITION No.14832 OF 2017

ORDER:

The grievance of the petitioners is that one S.R.Gopal, who is the father-in-law of 1st petitioner and father of the 2nd petitioner was assigned loani pattas in the year 1974 for an extent of Ac.5-00 cents in Sy.No.578/36 of Rudraram Village and revenue authorities issued "Boomi Hakku Record" and pattadar passbook in his name. Since then the petitioners and their family have been cultivating the subject land and paying cist regularly. Since the date of assignment in the year 1974-75, the name of 2nd petitioner's father was entered in revenue records. When the 2nd petitioner's father died about 30 years back, the petitioners continued to cultivate the subject land but being ignorant did not approach the revenue authority for necessary corrections in revenue records. In the year 2016, the petitioners approached the revenue authorities and requested to mutate the name of 2nd petitioner in place of her father and issue pattadar passbooks and title deeds, as she is descendent of the assignee, her late father. Due to inaction of the revenue authorities, the petitioner made representation on 16-12-2016 to the 3rd respondent seeking mutation and issue pattadar passbook and title deeds in respect of the subject land. As no orders are passed on the same, the present writ petition is filed.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue.

In view of the above facts and circumstances of the case, this writ petition is disposed of directing the 3rd respondent to dispose of the representation of the petitioners dated 16-12-2016 and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law. Said exercise shall be done within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

As a sequel to the disposal of this petition, miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending shall stand closed.
