

HONOURABLE SRI JUSTICE RAJA ELANGO

WRIT PETITION No.778 of 2017

ORDER:

1. This writ petition is filed by the petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking to quash the proceedings against her in FIR No.288 of 2016 on the file of the II Town Police Station, Mahabubnagar.
2. Heard and perused the material available on record.
3. It is stated in the affidavit that the above crime was registered for the offences under Sections 376(1), 417 and 420 r/w 109 IPC. The allegation against the petitioner is that she facilitated for commission of the offences by the other accused. It is the case of the petitioner that she did not commit any offence as alleged.
4. The petitioner filed this writ petition challenging the investigation in the above crime. This Court is not inclined to interfere with the investigation in the above crime. However, the official respondents are directed to complete the investigation and file a final report, in accordance with law, without arresting the petitioner. The petitioner is directed to appear before the Station House Officer concerned as and when required and the petitioner is also directed to execute a personal bond for a sum of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only) with one surety for the like sum to the satisfaction of the Station House Officer concerned, as surety for her future appearance as and when required for the purpose of investigation.
5. With the above direction, the Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs. Consequently, miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
