

THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE C. PRAVEEN KUMAR

WRIT PETITION No.16625 OF 2017

ORDER:

This Writ Petition, under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, came to be filed seeking to declare the inaction of the respondents in taking action in pursuance to the complaint lodged on 03.04.2017 against the 5th respondent and his associates, as illegal and arbitrary.

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home. With their consent, the Writ Petition is disposed of at the stage of admission itself. Since this Court is not going into the merits of the case, there is no necessity to issue notice to respondent No.5.

Learned AGP on instructions submits that since the petitioner is not co-operating with respondents-Police, they are unable to proceed further on the report given by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner will furnish all the documents and co-operate with Police by furnishing necessary documents.

Recording the said submissions, the Writ Petition is disposed of, directing the respondents-Police to co-operate with Police by furnishing necessary documents, in which event, the respondents-Police shall proceed further in accordance with law.

Miscellaneous petitions pending in this writ petition, if any,
shall stand closed. There shall be no order as to costs.
