

THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE C. PRAVEEN KUMAR

WRIT PETITION No.22625 of 2017

ORDER:

This Writ Petition, under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, came to be filed seeking to declare the inaction of the third respondent in conducting investigation in crime No.225 of 2016 of Armour Police Station, Nizamabad District, registered for the offence punishable under Section 435 of Indian Penal Code, as illegal and arbitrary.

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner as well as the learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home. With their consent, the Writ Petition is disposed of at the stage of admission itself.

The limited grievance of the petitioner in this Writ Petition is that though crime No.225 of 2016 was registered on 09.08.2016, the respondents-Police have not completed the investigation till date.

Having regard to the facts in issue and since the crime is registered in the month of August, 2016, the Writ Petition is disposed of directing the respondents-Police to complete investigation and file a final report in crime No.225 of 2016, as early as possible, preferably within a period of three to six months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

Miscellaneous petitions pending in this writ petition, if any, shall stand closed. No costs.
