TRANSFER C.M.P.No.682 of 2017

ORDER :

Notice sent to the respondent returned unclaimed and to the advocate shown served. Taken as sufficient service.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the grounds urged in the transfer petition filed by the petitioners to withdraw F.C.O.P.No.156 of 2017 from the file of the Judge, Family Court, Rajamahendravaram, East Godavari District, filed by the husband of petitioner No.1 for restitution of conjugal rights, to the file of the Judge, Family Court, Vijayawada, Krishna District, where M.C.No.256 of 2017 filed by the petitioners seeking maintenance is pending.

3. In view of the settled expressions of the Apex Court in **T. Gayatri Devi v. Dr.Tallepaneni Sreekanth¹** and **Amita Shah v. Virender Lal Shah²**, that the inconvenience caused to be the wife must be weighed when compared to that of the husband in matrimonial matters in considering the transfer applications, the present transfer petition is allowed and F.C.O.P.No.156 of 2017 pending on the file of the Judge, Family Court, Rajamahendravaram, East Godavari District, is withdrawn and transferred to the Judge, Family Court, Vijayawada, Krishna District. The Judge, Family Court, Vijayawada, shall post F.C.O.P.No.156 of 2017 along with

M.C.No.256 of 2017 even dates, by virtue of this order, so that there will be little convenience, and shall not insist the personal appearance of the parties herein if representing through advocate under Section 13 of the Family Courts Act, if any, but for reconciliation and for giving of evidence, including in the maintenance case under Section 126(2) Cr.P.C.

Miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed. No order as to costs.
