

THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE T.SUNIL CHOWDARY

CRIMINAL PETITION NO.1290 OF 2017

ORDER:

This petition is filed by the petitioners/A21 and A22 under Section 482 Cr.P.C. to quash the proceedings in C.C.No.182 of 2016 on the file of the VII Additional Metropolitan Magistrate, Bheemunipatnam.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned counsel for the 2nd respondent.

3. At the time of hearing, the only relief sought for by the learned counsel for the petitioners is to dispense with the presence of the petitioners before the trial Court on each and every date of adjournment.

4. In view of the submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, this Court is not inclined to go into the merits of the main case.

5. There is no dispute with regard to the identity of the petitioners. Even if the presence of the petitioners is dispensed with, no prejudice would be caused to the 2nd respondent. Therefore, presence of the petitioners-A21 and A22 in C.C.No.182 of 2016 on the file of the VII Additional Metropolitan Magistrate, Bheemunipatnam, is dispensed with on each and every date of adjournment. However, they shall appear before the trial Court as and when their presence is so required.

6. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is disposed of. Miscellaneous petitions, if any pending, in this Criminal Petition shall stand closed.
