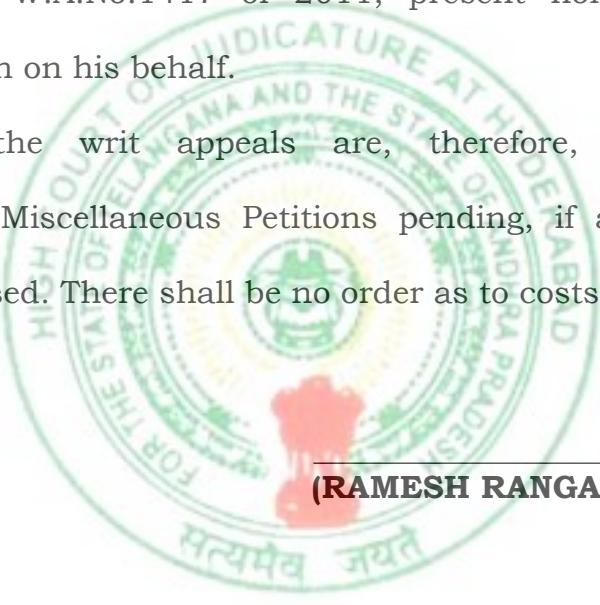
Writ Appeal Nos.1059 and 1417 of 2011

COMMON JUDGMENT: (Per the Hon'ble The Acting Chief Justice Ramesh Ranganathan)

Smt. K. Udaya Sri, learned counsel for the appellants in W.A. No. 1059 of 2011, and respondent in W.A. No. 1417 of 2011, submits that the cause in the writ appeals do not survive, and the writ appeals have become infructuous.
