Sri Vedula Srinivas, learned counsel for the petitioner, would fairly state that the petitioner-company has been closed down and its assets are being put to sale piece-meal. The action of the respondent in seeking to recover the property tax is put in issue in this writ petition.

As the petitioner has a statutory remedy of an appeal, we see no reason to entertain this writ petition. Leaving it open to the petitioner to avail its statutory remedy of appeal, the writ petition is dismissed. Miscellaneous Petitions pending, if any, shall also stand dismissed. There shall be no order as to costs.
