

**THE HONOURABLE SRI JUSTICE M.S.RAMACHANDRA RAO**

**WP.No.36399 of 2017**

**ORDER:**

Petitioner seeks mutation of his name in the revenue records by the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent on the basis of a request dt.06.07.2017 made by him to the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent.

2. The Government Pleader for Revenue appearing for respondents states that the petitioner ought to apply in Form 6A prescribed under the A.P. Rights in Land and Pattadar Passbook Act, 1971 (for short 'the Act') to the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent and if such application is made, 4<sup>th</sup> respondent will consider the same after issuing notices to respondents 5 and 6 also.

3. In view of the said submission, this Writ Petition is disposed of directing the petitioner to make an application in Form 6A as prescribed under the Act to the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent seeking mutation of his name in revenue records, and if such application is made, the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent, within two (02) months from the date of receipt of such application, shall dispose of the same in accordance with law, after issuing notices and hearing respondents 5 and 6. No costs.

4. Consequently, miscellaneous petitions pending if any shall stand closed.
