COMMON ORDER:

Crl.P.M.P.Nos. 13495 and 13496 of 2017

These two Petitions are filed seeking leave of this Court to compound the offences in C.C.No.1086 of 2017 on the file of XXI Metropolitan Magistrate, Medchal and to record compromise as the matter is settled outside the Court due to invention of elders and well wishers.

De facto complaint and the accused are present in person and they are identified by their respective counsel and they also produced the copies of Aadhar Cards in proof of their identity.

On enquiry, the parties stated that they settled the issue outside the Court due to intervention of elders and well-wishers and they intend to lead peaceful life.

As the matter settled outside the Court, if the Court insists to proceed with the trial, there is every possibility of turning the witnesses hostile. Hence, to avoid the waste of Court time, as the matter settled outside the Court, to put quietus to the dispute, I find that it is a fit case to grant permission to compound the offences punishable under Sections 498-A, 354, 340, 506 IPC and Sections 3 and 4 of DP Act.

Accordingly, these two Petitions are allowed permitting the parties to compound the offences in C.C.No.1086 of 2017 on the file of XXI Metropolitan Magistrate, Medchal.

CrI.P.No.12171 of 2017

In view of the Orders passed in CrI.P.Nos.13495 and 13496 of 2017, this Criminal Petition is allowed and the proceedings in C.C.No.1086 of 2017 on the file of XXI Metropolitan Magistrate, Medchal, are hereby quashed. The Registry is directed to annex a copy of the joint memo filed by the parties to the present petition.

As a sequel, miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending in this case, shall stand dismissed.
