

**HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE A.RAJASHEKER REDDY**

**WRIT PETITION No.41501 OF 2017**

**ORDER:**

This Writ Petition is filed seeking writ of mandamus declaring the action of the respondent No.4 in passing the proceeding in Rc.B.989/2017, dated 14.11.2017 referring the matter to the Civil Court, without any documentary evidence, as illegal and arbitrary.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and Sri S.S.Varma, learned Standing Counsel for 1<sup>st</sup> respondent.

It is the grievance of the petitioners that the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent has addressed letter dated 14.11.2017 to the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent for referring the matter to Civil Court, without any basis.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that without any basis and without any valid documents, impugned orders have been issued referring the matter to the Civil Court.

A perusal of the letter dated 14.11.2017 addressed by the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent to the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent goes to show that it is an internal correspondence between the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> respondents and as on today, the matter is not referred.

In view of the same, the writ petition is premature and same is liable to be dismissed and accordingly dismissed. However, liberty is granted to the petitioners to challenge the

same, as and when any proceedings are issued referring the matter to Civil Court.

There shall be no order as to costs. As a sequel to the disposal of this Writ Petition, miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending shall stand dismissed.
