Learned counsel for petitioner, after arguing the writ petition for some time and taking note of the view this Court is proposing to take i.e., the remedy of appeal can be availed against the orders impugned in the Writ Petition, seeks four weeks time from today to file appeal before Industrial Tribunal (Central) and to protect the interest of petitioner in the meantime prays for stay of any coercive steps.
