This is an application under section 11(6) of the Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996, for appointment of a sole Arbitrator.

2. Respondent Nos.2, 3 and 4 have no objection to the learned Arbitrator nominated by the petitioner to be the sole Arbitrator in the matter. Respondent No.1 is only the Chairman of respondent No.2 and is, therefore, neither a necessary nor a proper party.

3. The petition is, therefore, disposed of by confirming the appointment of the learned Arbitrator nominated by the petitioner as the sole Arbitrator and clarifying that the arbitration shall not include respondent No.1.
