This is a petition under Section 11(6) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 for the appointment of an arbitrator.

2. The agreement entered into between the parties contains an arbitration clause. The disputes are to be referred to the Superintending Engineer of the circle concerned which is now not possible. In any event, the petitioner invoked the arbitration agreement by a letter dated 10.05.2016, inter alia, by calling upon the respondents to appoint an arbitrator. There has been no response to the same to date.

3. The petition is, therefore, disposed of by appointing Mr. A. S. Narula, a retired Additional District Judge, Punjab, as the sole arbitrator. The fees shall be as per the Chandigarh Arbitration Centre (CAC) (Administrative Cost and Arbitrators' Fees) Rules, 2014.
