This is a petition under Section 11 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 for the appointment of an arbitrator.

2. The parties had admittedly entered into an agreement. The agreement contains an arbitration clause. The petitioner invoked the arbitration clause. The respondents, however, did not appoint an arbitrator till the petition was filed. They have not appointed an arbitrator to date.

3. The petition is, therefore, disposed of by appointing Mr. B.R Gupta, a retired Additional District and Sessions Judge, Haryana, as the sole arbitrator. The fees shall be as per the Chandigarh Arbitration Centre (CAC) (Administrative Cost and Arbitrators’ Fees) Rules, 2014.

4. The venue shall be the Chandigarh Arbitration Centre.
