This is a petition under Section 11 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 for the appointment of an arbitrator.

2. The parties had admittedly entered into a contract which contains an arbitration agreement. The respondents contend that they had paid the entire dues. The matter was adjourned to ascertain the same. The petitioner states that an amount of about ₹34 lacs remains to be paid. This is a dispute that must be determined in arbitration.

3. The petition is, therefore, disposed of by appointing Hon'ble Mr. Justice Rajive Bhalla, a retired Judge of this Court, as the sole arbitrator. The venue shall be the Chandigarh Arbitration Centre.
