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S. J. VAZIDAR, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral):

This is an application under section 11 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, for appointment of an arbitral Tribunal or, in the alternative, an independent Arbitrator.

A panel comprising of three learned Arbitrators was constituted. Unfortunately, one of the Arbitrators died. The matter has been pending since the year 2003. The parties have, therefore, requested me to appoint only a sole Arbitrator with a view to saving time and cost.

As agreed, the petition is disposed of by appointing Shri Anil Kumar Singh Panwar, District & Sessions Judge (Retd.), Haryana, as a sole Arbitrator. The venue shall be the Chandigarh Arbitration Centre. The fee shall be as per the Chandigarh Arbitration Centre (CAC) (Administrative Cost and Arbitrators' Fees) Rules, 2014.
