The affidavit has been stated to be filed by learned State counsel before this Court on 01.09.2015 but the same is not on record. A copy of said affidavit has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

Learned State counsel submits that the order passed by this Court on 05.05.2015 has been complied with to the extent that sacred 'Relics' of Shri Guru Gobind Singh were taken across the State of Punjab for displaying the same for Sangat Darshan w.e.f. 06.05.2015 and after passing through various parts of the State, the relics have finally been installed/displayed at Takhat Sri Keshgarh Sahib, Anandpur Sahib on 18.06.2015. It has also been mentioned in the order that the directions issued by this Court were to be complied with within a period of three months but there is delay in implementing the orders and for that, an unconditional apology has been tendered by the Principal Secretary to Government of Punjab, Department of Cultural Affairs, Archaeology and Museums, Chandigarh.

The order has been complied with in pursuance of order passed by this Court but still the petitioner is not satisfied as a direction was also there to the respondent to consider the representation of the petitioner but the same has not been considered as per averments mentioned therein.

The present petition is disposed of.

However, in case, the petitioner is still aggrieved in any manner, he is at liberty to avail the appropriate remedy.
