The petitioner had filed CRM-M No.4949 of 2016 seeking directions to the official respondents to transfer the investigation of FIR No.140 dated 12.10.2015, registered at her instance under Sections 406 and 498-A, IPC, Police Station Sarhali, District Tarn Taran to an Officer not below the rank of DSP. The said petition was disposed of vide order dated 11.02.2016 (**Annexure P-1**) with a direction to the SSP, Tarn Taran (respondent No.3 therein) to decide the representation of the petitioner at his own level. Since the needful was not done, hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, compliance report by way of affidavit dated 19.12.2016 of Sh. Manmohan Kumar, PPS, Sr. Supdt. of Police, Tarn Taran, Punjab has been filed, wherein it is submitted that representation of the petitioner has been considered and filed, vide order dated 17.11.2016 (**Annexure R-1**), as the allegations levelled by the petitioner were not proved/substantiated.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the respondent submits that the aforesaid directions passed by this Court have already been complied with. He has also explained the reasons for delay in complying with the orders passed by this Court. The explanation is reasonable and accepted.

In view of the above, no further action is warranted.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
