Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 1.12.2010, the claim of the petitioner has been considered and pay of the petitioner has been revised w.e.f. 1.1.1996 and same has been intimated to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that arrears of 38 months have also been deposited in his account and same has been confirmed by the petitioner himself. Learned counsel also submits that pension as well as gratuity has also been revised.

Since the compliance of the order has been made, nothing survives in the present contempt petition and the same is disposed of accordingly.
