The petitioner, who retired from Treasuries Office, Gurgaon on 20.8.1992 and was seeking his pensionary dues, has preferred this contempt petition for non-compliance of order dated 17.9.2015 passed by this Court in CWP No.28593 of 2013, which was allowed while directing the respondents to release the pensionary dues of the petitioner and other consequential benefits, which have been illegally withheld by them as expeditiously as possible but not later than three months besides interest as decreed by the Civil Court.

Upon notice, an affidavit of Sunil Kumar Sharma, Joint Director Treasuries & Accounts Department Haryana Chandigarh has been filed in Court today wherein it is stated that the

following payments towards pensionary benefits have been released by Treasury Officer, Gurgaon to the petitioner:
