Petitioner has preferred the instant contempt petition under Section 10 read with Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 against the respondents for not complying with the order dated 27.05.2010 (P-1) passed by this Court in CWP No.8509 of 2007, whereby respondents were directed to appoint the petitioner pursuant to his selection as JBT Teacher by giving him notional benefits such as fixation of pay, increments, seniority etc., from the date persons junior to the petitioner have been appointed.

At the time of hearing, learned State Counsel submits that the necessary compliance of the order dated 27.05.2010 (P-1) passed by this Court has been made and nothing survives in the present contempt petition

for adjudication.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is hereby dismissed as infructuous.
