The respondent(s)/Corporation, pursuant to the final decree dated 08.02.2013 (**Annexure P-6**) passed in **Regular Second Appeal No.4205 of 2012** titled as **Punjab State Electricity Board and another *Versus* Raj Kiran'** have passed an office order dated 28.02.2014, whereby the petitioner has been offered an appointment of the Work Charge Sweeper.

It was contended on behalf of the petitioner that the decree had directed the appointment as Regular Work Charge Sweeper and by offering appointment as Work Charge Sweeper, the respondents have violated the decree passed by this Court.

Learned Counsel for the respondents points out that as there is no post of Regular Work Charge Sweeper available in their Establishment, therefore, as per the decree, an offer of appointment was made as Work Charge Sweeper to the petitioner. He further submits that even this Court in the present contempt petition, vide order dated 18.02.2016, had noticed that the decree, if at all needed clarification, which upon an appropriate clarification, has been dismissed.

In view of the above, it is apparent that there is substantial compliance of the order, which warranting no further action.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
