Mr. Arvinder Singh Bains, IAS, the Managing Director Punjab Ware Housing Corporation, presently posted as the Claims Commissioner is present in the Court and has explained that delay is not on his part and it has occurred due to act of the petitioners. He also submits that now he has been transferred from that post and a new incumbent is likely to join the duty before the authority on 10.7.2017.

By considering the submission made by the respondent, it is directed that the claim of the petitioner be decided either on the next date or on the subsequent date, in case the concerned officer joins duty preferably within a period of three months from the date of joining of the

concerned officer.

The contempt petition is disposed of.

In case, the claim of the petitioner is not decided within the aforesaid period, the petitioners are at liberty to move an application for revival of the petition.
