The petitioner had filed CWP No.17988 of 2011 seeking retiral benefits. The said petition was disposed of with a direction to the respondents to compute the retiral benefits and release them to the petitioner within three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of the order, failing which, she would be entitled to recover the same with interest @ 8% per annum from the date of retirement till the date of payment. Since the needful was not done, hence the present contempt petition.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioner concedes that the aforesaid directions have since been complied with.

In view of the statement made by learned Counsel for the petitioner, no further action is warranted.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
