Learned counsel for the respondent submits that in pursuance of order dated 20.10.2016 passed in CWP No.21815 of 2016, a speaking order has been passed on 19.07.2017, which is annexed as Annexure R-1 with the reply.

Since compliance of the order has been made, the present contempt petition is disposed of accordingly.

Petitioner is at liberty to avail the appropriate remedy in case he is aggrieved in any manner.

The compliance of the order was to be made within a period of three months and the order has been complied with after a period of nine

months. Although the reasons have been mentioned for taking the decision late, but the respondent could have moved application for extension of time, therefore, an amount of ₹10,000/- is imposed as cost upon the respondent for taking the decision beyond the stipulated period, to be paid to the petitioner by way of bank draft.
