Petitioner has approached this Court for non-compliance of the order dated 02.03.2017 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court whereby the Court had requested the official respondents to respond to the petitioner's representations dated 11.07.2016 and 11.08.2016 without expressing any view on the correctness of the petitioner's allegations. The said order is said to have been conveyed to the respondents on 12.04.2017.

Hardly any time has gone by from the date the order has been conveyed to the respondents. Apart from that, there is no time bound direction or even an observation to that effect made in the order dated 02.03.2017 which would indicate non-compliance of the order passed by this Court on the part of the respondents.
