JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

The petitioner had filed CRM-M No.38302 of 2016 seeking direction to the S.P., Fatehabad (respondent No.3 therein) to consider the representation dated 13.08.2016. The said petition was disposed of vide order dated 25.10.2016 (**Annexure P-1**) with a direction to the S.P., Fatehabad to look into the said representation and pass appropriate order within two months, as per law, after receiving the certified copy of the order. Since the needful was not done, hence the present contempt petition.

At the time of hearing, learned State Counsel for the respondent, assisted by ASI Bhim Singh, submits that the present contempt petition has become infructuous as upon an enquiry, an FIR No.113 against Saraswati and Mahinder has since been registered on 06.05.2017 at Police Station Bhattu Kalan for the offences under Section 420 read with Section 34, IPC.

In response, learned Counsel for the petitioner concedes that the present contempt petition has become infructuous.

In view of the above, no further action is warranted.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition is dismissed as infructuous.
