Learned counsel for the respondent has filed short reply by way of affidavit of respondent stating therein that pay scales of the petitioners have been revised and arrears would be released within a period of two weeks.

In view of the submission made by learned counsel for the respondent, since the benefit in pursuance of direction dated 23.01.2017 has been granted and arrears will be paid within a period of two weeks. It was also ordered that in case of delay in releasing the benefits the petitioners would be entitled for interest.

Since compliance of the order is there, nothing survives in the contempt petition. In case the petitioners are still aggrieved in any manner they are at liberty to move an application to the authorities concerned. In case such representation is moved, the respondent-authorities are directed

to consider the same and pass necessary order in accordance with law.
