The petitioner had filed CWP No.21974 of 2015 for release of his salary for the period from 01.01.2009 to 21.08.2009 as well as transfer of Contributory Provident Fund for the period from May, 2005 to August, 2009. The said petition was disposed of vide order dated 14.10.2015 (**Annexure P-1**) with a direction to the Punjab State Social Welfare Advisory Board to decide the representation dated 19.01.2015 of the petitioner by passing a speaking order in accordance with law, preferably within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of the order. It was also directed that in case, the petitioner is found entitled to the release of his salary etc., the same be released to him within a period of six weeks thereafter. Since the needful was not done, hence the present contempt petition.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition has become infructuous as the directions passed by this Court have since been complied with.

In view of above, no further action is warranted.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
