DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.

An additional affidavit of Amrit Singh, Executive Engineer, Jui Water Services Division, Bhiwani has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that cost amount of ₹1 lac has been paid to the petitioner-workman and order of regularization has also been passed.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that consequential benefits have not been paid.

Since the order passed by this Court has been complied with, nothing survives in the present contempt petition and the same is accordingly disposed of.

However, as far as the claim of the petitioner with regard to consequential benefits after regularization is concerned, he is at liberty to move representation to the respondent-authorities within a period of one month from the date of receipt of copy of the order. In case such representation is made, the respondent-authorities are directed to consider the same and pass necessary order in accordance with law within a period of two months thereafter.

Disposed of accordingly.
