Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are also entitled for consequential benefits.

Since both the petitioners have been regularised from the date their juniors were regularised and thus, compliance of the order has been made, nothing survives in the present contempt petition and the same is disposed of accordingly.

In case the petitioners are entitled for certain consequential benefits, they are at liberty to move representation to the competent authority (respondent No.1). In case such representation is moved within

one month, the respondent-authority is directed to consider the same and take action in accordance with law.
