Petitioner alleges violation of order dated 20.02.2017, passed by the writ court. Operative part thereof reads as under:-

“This petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 that the legal notices Annexures P-2 to P-4 of the petitioner will be considered and decided within a period of two months after the receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case the petitioner is found entitled to payment of his dues, the same will be released, as per the provisions of rules and regulations.”

In certain connected matters, the concerned departments have released the payment. This court hopes and trust that payment, if due, shall be released to the petitioner at the earliest in any case, not later than six weeks. In case contempt is not purged within the aforesaid period, petitioner shall be at liberty to seek revival of the petition. In that eventuality, this court shall consider imposition of punitive costs, which shall be recoverable from the salary of the officials responsible for delay in releasing the payment.
