Petitioner had approached this Court alleging non-compliance of the order dated 22.05.2017 passed by the Division Bench of this Court in LPA No. 836 of 2017 titled as Dr. Vikas Malik vs. State of Haryana and others, wherein the petitioner, who was appellant there, had been permitted to participate in the counselling, which was stated to be underway for admission to the Post Graduate Course in PGIMS, Rohtak.

Counsel for the respondents submits that the petitioner had been permitted to participate in the counselling but there is a further development that is that the Hon'ble Supreme Court has quashed the said counselling. Fresh counselling is being held today and, therefore, the claim

of the petitioner, in compliance with the Division Bench order of this Court passed on 22.05.2017, shall be considered and he would be permitted to participate in the present counselling.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such.
