AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (Oral):

The present contempt petition was ordered to be listed for hearing alongwith CRR No.1447 of 1999, which was decided by this Court on 11.05.2000 but inadvertently, the present contempt petition was not listed alongwith the said Criminal Revision, the result thereof was that no order has been passed in the present contempt petition.

Perusal of the order dated 11.05.2000 passed by this Court in CRR No.1447 of 1999 would show that none of the parties is in possession of the land in dispute and the Tehsildar, Tehsil Mukerian, has been directed to get the standing crops harvested and sell the same in open market and deposit the sale proceeds in the Government Treasury after taking the necessary expenses to be paid to the person found entitled to the same. The Court had, as a matter of fact, remanded back the case to the Sessions Judge,

Hoshiarpur, for redetermination by setting aside the impugned order dated

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22.10.1999 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge.

In view of the above, counsel for the petitioner submits that the present contempt petition has been rendered infructuous. This explains non appearance of the counsel for the respondents despite he having been informed of the date fixed. As such, the present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged.
