The claim of the Petitioner company was for release of subsidy amount to be paid by the government as an incentive under a scheme of Incentives for Information & Technology Industries floated vide notification dated 15.03.2000 was disposed of by this Court vide order dated 19.05.2014 to be released within a period of six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order failing which the interest of 6% per annum from the date of judgment to the date of payment was liable to be paid.

Since the order was not complied with, the present contempt petition was filed.

Upon notice an affidavit dated 20.01.2017 of Mr. Jaspal Singh,

has been filed wherein it is stated that the entire due amount has since been submitted for clearance to the District Treasury, SAS Nagar, Mohali and the amount would soon be credited in the account of the petitioner company.

In view of the aforesaid assurance, it is conceded by the learned Counsel for the petitioner that nothing survives in the present petition for proceeding any further.

Dismissed as infructuous.

The State of Punjab shall be bound by their aforesaid assurance.
