Vide order dated 15.12.2015, writ petition was disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 3 to consider and decide legal notice dated 01.10.2015 by passing a speaking order expeditiously and preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that order dated 15.12.2015 has been complied with and speaking order has been passed. As per averment made in the contempt petition, copy of the order was supplied to the respondent and petitioner also made representation to the respondent on 15.04.2016.

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that copy of the order along with representation was received in the office of respondent in the month of April, 2016 and, thereafter, it was decided. Since compliance of the order is made; nothing survives and the contempt petition is disposed of accordingly.

However, the petitioner is still aggrieved in any manner, he is at liberty to avail appropriate remedy in accordance with law.
