Petitioner alleges violation of order dated 12.7.2016 passed by the writ court. Operative part thereof reads as under:-

“We, thus, dispose of these writ petitions, without expressing any views on merits with a direction to the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner and in case he is found entitled to the grant of some benefit in terms of the order (P-6), the monetary benefits, if any, shall be released to him within four months from the date a certified copy of this order is received. Disposed of. Dasti.”

Learned State counsel at the outset submits that aforesaid order shall be complied with at the earliest in any case not later than one month.

In view of above, no further direction is necessary. In case, fresh cause of action accrues to the petitioner to invoke the contempt jurisdiction of this court, exemplary costs shall be imposed which would be deducted from the salary of the officer(s) responsible for delay/non compliance.
