Petitioner appearing in person has submitted that he has received a communication from the Director-cum-Special Secretary, Local Government, Punjab regarding compliance of order dated 20.03.2017 which was passed in the miscellaneous application in earlier contempt petition. Photocopy of the decision taken pursuant to order dated 20.03.2017, is taken on record.

The petitioner appearing in person submits that the said order is not in compliance of order dated 20.03.2017 and is merely an eyewash.

Prima facie, the order passed on 20.03.2017 has been complied with by considering the grievance of the petitioner.

Petitioner appearing in person has submitted that the order which has been communicated to the petitioner, has been passed by an authority which is not competent and that the said order cannot be considered to be an order in the eyes of law.

I have heard the petitioner in person and gone through the directions passed by this Court on 20.03.2017.

As per the directions dated 20.03.2017, the matter has been reconsidered by passing an order in detail and the same has been communicated to the petitioner.

In view of said circumstances, there does not appear to be any willful disobedience of the order dated 20.03.2017.

In case, the petitioner is not satisfied with the legality and propriety of order dated 20.03.2017, copy of which has been placed on record, it will be open to the petitioner to challenge the same in accordance with law before the appropriate forum.

Disposed of with above observations.
