The petitioners had filed a pre-mature writ petition i.e. CWP No.19067 of 2016 which was disposed of by a Single Bench of this Court by following order:-

“Learned State counsel makes a statement that there is no agenda as regards consideration for promotion from the post of A.G.M Accounts to D.G.M. Accounts under the Haryana State Cooperative Supply and Marketing Federation Limited (HAFED). He further submits that as and when such agenda is taken up all eligible employees would be granted consideration for promotion and in accordance with law.

In the light of statement made by learned State counsel, no further directions are required to be passed in the instant petition and the same is, accordingly, disposed of”.

The petitioner has filed the contempt petition stating that the petitioner has not been considered despite his eligibility and promotions have been made.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner at length and I am of the opinion that if the petitioner is aggrieved by the promotions made

ignoring the eligibility of the petitioner, he would certainly have a right to challenge the same at departmental level or by availing the legal remedy.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at this stage, seeks permission to withdraw the petition with liberty to challenge the promotion order Annexure P-3 in accordance with law.

Disposed of as withdrawn with said liberty.
